MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between:

World Association of Radiopharmaceutical and Molecular Therapy (WARMTH)
and the Latin American Association of Societies of Biology and Nuclear Medicine
(ALASBIMN)

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is effective as of March 14, 2025, between the World Association of Radiopharmaceutical and Molecular Therapy (WARMTH) and the Latin American Association of Societies of Biology and Nuclear Medicine (ALASBIMN). The parties agree as follows:

Article 1: Purpose and Scope

To expand collaboration between ALASBIMN and WARMTH.

Article 2: Areas of Collaboration

The areas of collaboration between WARMTH and ALASBIMN could include, but are not limited to, the following initiatives:

- Mutual exchange of educational activities aimed at continuing medical education of nuclear medicine professionals in molecular imaging and theranostics.
- WARMTH may contribute toward educational symposiums in association with ALASBIMN.
- Joint activities for the promotion of Nuclear Medicine and molecular imaging and theranostics in collaboration with other scientific societies in Latin America and Europe.
- Both societies will share information about their respective training activities, committing to disseminate them among their members.
- The signatory societies will mutually share, if available, their respective newsletters and logos.
- Both societies will include on their respective websites a link to the website of the society signing this agreement.
- Offering free booth space and up to 2 complimentary exhibitor registrations for the visiting society at the congress.

- Each society will grant up to 3 free congress registrations for members of the respective Board of Directors of the other society.

Article 3: Timing

Leadership meetings shall be held at least once a year at an international congress.

Article 4: Future Cooperation

The present MOU will be valid for 3 years.
After 3 years, this MOU can be revised by both parties.

Addendums may be made at the annual meetings in agreement with both parties. The present MOU outlines the general conditions and arrangements for future cooperation between the interested parties. It is not legally binding on the parties. The exact terms and conditions of this future cooperation will be negotiated.
